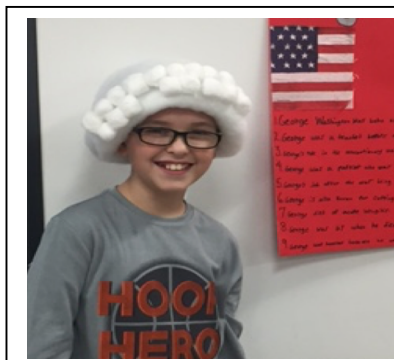
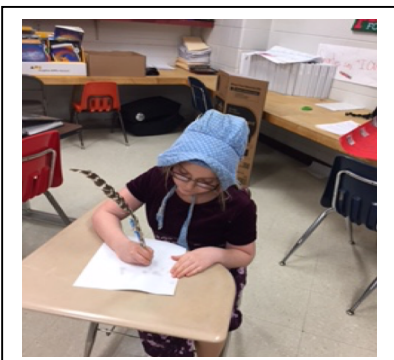

The American Revolution

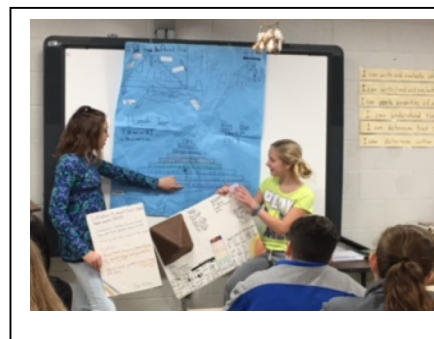
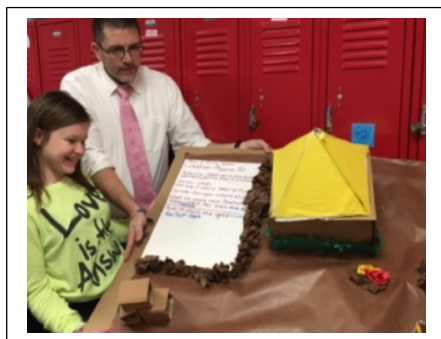
Mrs. Taulbee's fifth graders have been studying "The American Revolution."

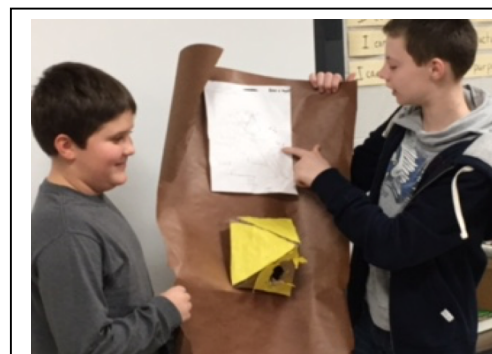

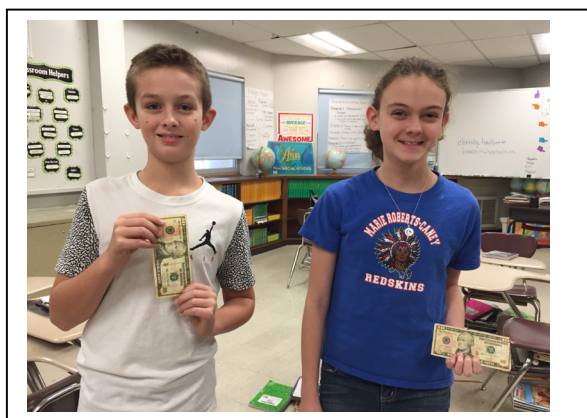
6th Grade Pyramids



Research, exploration and creativity led Mr. Turner's class through an in-depth lesson about the Egyptian pyramids. After reading and discussing a non-fiction writing in their reading books, the students expanded their learning through student led online research. Afterward, they used the knowledge gained to create their own pyramid plan. Tasked with developing a plan to build a pyramid anywhere in the world using materials plentiful in their chosen area, the students wrote a plan to build their tombs. Their students used their creativity to develop new shapes and build on the ancient ideas. The more the students learned the more creative their ideas became. The project concluded with each group delivering a speech to explain their pyramids.
