MRC SBDM Meeting Regular Session November 15, 2016

Marlene Hamilton made the motion to call the meeting to order at 4:00 PM. Chris Banks seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.

Budget:

Mr. Fugate presented the council with the updated budget, including the 2nd month's attendance being reworked. (see attachment)

Student data:
